Day 1 April 22, Sunday: Depart USA

Depart JFK International Airport on EL AL Israel Airlines for our non-stop flight to Tel Aviv. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served inflight. (D,B,L)

Day 2 April 23, Monday: Arrive in the Holy Land | Jaffa | Netanya

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour guide will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our private tour bus and we will be on our way to the old port of Joppa (Jaffa). It was from Joppa that Jonah embarked on his ill-fated voyage to Tarshish. Also in Joppa, Peter had his vision in the house of Simon the tanner. **Celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church.** Continue to the scenic Mediterranean coast for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at the Sofitel David Tower Hotel in Netanya. (D)

Day 3 April 24, Tuesday: Caesarea | Mt. Carmel | Nazareth | Cana | Sea of Galilee

Theme: The Annunciation ...The Word became flesh...(John 1:14)
 Buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a visit to Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community, where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. It was here that St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles. Our visit includes the theatre, newly excavated Palace, Hippodrome and Harbor. Continue to Mt. Carmel (Vineyard of God) on the Mediterranean coast. Here Elijah triumphed over the pagan prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. **Time will be given for prayer at the monastery.** Continue through Jezreel Valley, passing Tel Meggido, to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass at the Grotto of the Annunciation** (subject to confirmation). **Group lunch at the Franciscan Casa Nova Guest House.** After lunch, explore the excavations and magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation built over the house of Our Lady. Contemplate the mystery of the Incarnation and explore the beautiful basilica built in 1968. We will also visit the house of the Holy Family, Mary's Well and the traditional synagogue that Jesus would have visited as a young boy and as an adult. Afterwards, we will drive to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first public miracle changing water into wine. Visit the Franciscan Church built over the traditional location of the "wedding hall". **Couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows.** Continue to the Sea of Galilee, for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at the Pilgerhaus. (B,L,D)

Day 4 April 25, Wednesday: Around the Sea of Galilee

Theme: The Ministry of Christ in Galilee
 Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, drive across the Plain of Gennesaret to the biblical site of Magdala, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. Continue to the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry. It was here that Jesus found Matthew and called him to discipleship. Here, the excellent condition of a 2nd century synagogue undoubtedly enclosed the sacred sanctuary in which Jesus taught and preached. Most scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. Visit Tabgha, where Jesus challenged His disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. **Continue to the Church of the Primacy of Peter and celebrate Mass outdoors.** Here, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to "feed my lambs; feed my sheep". After Mass, we visit the Church of the Multiplication. **Group lunch at Kibbutz Nof Ginosar.** Enjoy this afternoon's boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and made the miraculous catch of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). We disembark and drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel. The foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, is where Jesus appeared to Paul. Visit Caesarea Philippi and see the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). We will reflect here on Peter's response to Jesus, "...You are the Messiah..." (Matthew 16:16). Return to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus offered His "Sermon on the Mount." Dinner and overnight at the Pilgerhaus. (B,L,D)

Day 5 April 26, Thursday: Mt. Tabor | Jordan River | Jericho | Jerusalem

Theme: The Transfiguration & the Wilderness
 Breakfast at the hotel. Today we leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Mt. Tabor. We will take a taxi to the top of Mt. Tabor for a commanding view of all of Galilee. Visit the site of the Transfiguration, with time to reflect on Christ's humanity and divinity, good preparation for the journey to Jerusalem where Jesus was to suffer the crucifixion and resurrection. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Drive along the Jordan Valley, blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits and vegetables. Continue to the Jordan River to visit the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist (Matthew: 3:13-17). It is also considered to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. **We will have the opportunity to renew our baptismal promises at the Jordan River. Group lunch at a restaurant in Jericho.** Explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles, and the Mt. of Temptation. Continue to Jerusalem. En-route, we view the site of Herodian Jericho, the Wadi Quilt, and the Monastery of Saints John and George of Coziba. Check-in at the Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 6 April 27, Friday: Old City | Temple Mount | Bethlehem | Shepherd's Field

Theme: Early years in Jerusalem & The Nativity
 Buffet breakfast at hotel. We drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Our walking tour of the Old City continues as we visit the Temple Mount. We will have time for prayer and reflection at the Western Wall of the Temple Mount. Above the Temple foundations, see the El Aksa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. We will also visit the excavation below the temple area. Late morning, we leave Jerusalem for the hills of Bethlehem where you can read the biblical account of Ruth, David and the birth of Jesus. Visit the Paul VI Ephpheta Institute and Bethlehem University, the only Catholic higher education institute in the Holy Land. **Group lunch at the School of Hotel Management at Bethlehem University.** The highlight of our time in Bethlehem will be a visit to the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Nativity.** Continue on to visit Shepherds' Field, where you will see some of the caves, which are typical of the stables of that time. We also visit the nearby Milk Grotto Chapel. Return to hotel to freshen-up. **Before dinner, we will have a briefing by the Director for Palestine-Israel of the Pontifical Mission for Palestine (aka CNEWA).** Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 7 April 28, Saturday: Mt. Olives | Mt. Zion | Solemn Entry and Latin Patriarchate

Theme: Palm Sunday & the Agony in the Garden
 Buffet breakfast at hotel. Drive to the top of the Mount of Olives and visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Dominus Flevit (The Lord Wept). Follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of All Nations. Return to the Notre Dame Center for group lunch.** After lunch, continue to Mt. Zion to visit the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu, built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Visit the Cenacle and the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Walk through the Zion Gate to the Armenian Quarter to the Cathedral of Saint James. **Early evening, walk to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre to experience a Solemn Entry to the Holy Sepulchre accompanied by the Franciscan priests.** Afterwards, we visit the Latin Patriarchate for a special audience with the Latin Patriarch (subject to confirmation). **Knights and Ladies making a pilgrimage to Jerusalem to pray at the site of the Holy Sepulchre of Our Risen Lord, can earn the Pilgrim Shell. It testifies that the Knight or Lady has seen the results of his or her charity and knows the importance of the mission of the Order and the fulfillment of the apostolate. It is the goal of every member.** Dinner and overnight at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 8 April 29, Sunday: Via Dolorosa | Church of the Holy Sepulchre | Bethany

Theme: The Crucifixion & Resurrection
 Early morning, we walk in the footsteps of Jesus during his Passion. Start at the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the Chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned. Walk the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, where time will be given for prayer and reflection. Return to the hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, **walk to the Melkite Greek Catholic Patriarchate for the 9:30am Divine Liturgy at the Church of the Patriarchate. Group lunch at the Notre Dame Center.** This afternoon, drive to Beit Jala to visit the Latin Patriarchal Seminary. On our way back to Jerusalem, drive to the town of Bethany, home of Lazarus, Mary and Martha. Return to the hotel to freshen-up. **Before dinner, we will have a reception with the Apostolic Delegate in Jerusalem and Palestine at the Apostolic Nunciature** (subject to confirmation). Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 9 April 30, Monday: Emmaus | St. Rachel Center | Ein Karem

Theme: The Visitation
 Early morning, **celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.** Return to hotel for buffet breakfast. This morning, we visit the site of Emmaus (Abu Gosh). **Prayer and reflection at the Church of Our Lady of the Ark of the Covenant.** Continue to the St. Rachel Center, a new initiative of the Catholic Church that cares for the children of migrants and refugees in Israel. We will meet with staff and spend time with children at the Day Care center. Independent lunch. This afternoon, visit Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth, Zachariah, and birthplace of John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Time will be given for quiet meditation on the meeting between these two mothers, Mary and Elizabeth. Verses from the *Magnificat* are engraved on the columns of the church, and on the wall opposite it are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the *Magnificat* in forty-two different languages. Visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, where according to tradition is the birthplace of John the Baptist. Return to Jerusalem. Farewell dinner at the Ambassador Hotel. Overnight at the Notre Dame Center. (B,D)

Day 10 May 1, Tuesday: Return to the USA

Early morning, transfer to Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight to the USA. This afternoon, arrive at New York's JFK International Airport, overflowing with memories that will change your life. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from New York on EL AL Israel Airlines. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple rooms because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$650.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily, including a farewell dinner. Six (6) lunches at restaurants throughout the pilgrimage. Two (2) glasses of wine per person included at dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities for the bus and tour manager are included in your tour package. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave a \$1.00 per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.
