Day 1 Monday, September 9: Depart for Italy

Depart on an overnight flight to Venice, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the flight.

Day 2 Tuesday, September 10: Arrive in Venice

Arrive at Marco Polo Venice Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager in the Arrivals Hall. We will board our private motorcoach and be on our way to the hotel for check-in. Afternoon at leisure. Celebrate Mass (location to be advised).

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Mestre or Venice.

(B,D) Day 3 Wednesday, September 11: St. Mark's Basilica I Walking Tour

of Venice

Breakfast at hotel. This morning we will travel to Venice by boat. Arrive at St. Mark's Square, then walk to St. Mark's Basilica to celebrate Mass. Independent lunch in Venice. Enjoy a walking tour of Venice beginning in the hub of activity, Piazza San Marco, which is lined with galleries, luxury shops, and charming cafes. The magnificent Basilica San Marco dominates the square. We will see a mixture of architectural styles (Byzantine, Romanesque, and Gothic) reflecting Venice's history. Continue to the Bridge of Sighs and visit Doges' Palace and the Piombi Prison. Continue to Chiesa di San Zaccaria, a 15th-century monastic church dedicated to St. Zechariah, the father of John the Baptist. A highlight is Giovanni Bellini's altarpiece, Madonna and Four Saints. Late afternoon, return to hotel.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Mestre or Venice.

Day 4 Thursday, September 12: Island of San Giorgio Maggiore

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, take a motorboat to the island of San Giorgio Maggiore. The island belonged to the Patrician family of the Memmo's (it was called Mummia Island). In the 7th century, a little church in honor of San Giorgio was erected and the name was changed to Isola di San Giorgio Maggiore. Celebrate Mass at the Church of San Giorgio Maggiore. After Mass, visit the conclave room. Independent lunch. While in Venice you may wish to take a gondola ride along the picturesque canals with a local troubadour to serenade you.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Mestre or Venice. (B.D)

Day 5 Friday, September 13: Padua I Ravenna

Breakfast at hotel. This morning we will visit Padua and the Basilica of St. Anthony with its famous Chapel of the Relics. The Basilica also contains a mixture of Gothic, Romanesque, and Byzantine architecture and holds a huge collection of art treasures. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of St. Anthony. Continue to the beautiful Basilica of St. Justina with its circular moat and famous 17th-century oval garden. We will have an opportunity to pray near the relics of St. Luke and St. Mathias. Visit the Church of the Capuchin Friars of Padua, better known as the Sanctuary of St. Leopold Mandić. His tomb is in a chapel adjacent to the room in which he heard countless confessions. Independent lunch.

Visit the Scrovegni Chapel (subject to confirmation): The Scrovegni Chapel is considered the most important building in the charming city of Padua. The restored frescoed interior is Giotto's magnificent depiction of the Life of Christ, the Virgin Mary, and the Last Judgment. These frescoes are considered his highest achievement. After our visit we will leave Padua and continue to Ravenna for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Ravenna.

Day 6 Saturday, September 14: Ravenna I Assisi

Breakfast at hotel, followed by morning tour of Ravenna where we will see wonderful Byzantine mosaics from the 6th and 7th centuries in the Basilicas of San Vitale and San Apollinare. Although the construction of San Vitale began under Archbishop Ecclesius (521-534), it was not finished until 547, and the mosaics were made under the authority of Justinian, whose general, Belisarius, took the city in 540. Artisans from Constantinople may have followed the army and had a hand in the mosaic work. At San Apollinare Nuovo we will see a scene of Christ flanked by his courtly angelic advisors and the last judgment, separating the sheep from the goats. The top row of mosaics shows twenty-six scenes from the life of Christ. The Ostrogothic mosaics were more inclined to treat Christ naturalistically and accommodate him within a Roman imperial framework. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. After Mass, we will also visit the Basilica of Saint Apollinaris in Classe and the tomb of Dante Independent lunch in Ravenna. Continue to Assisi for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Assisi.

Day 7 Sunday, September 15: Sites of St. Francis and St. Clare

Breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will **celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis.**Our local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica, built from 1228 to 1230, is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous San Damiano Crucifix. Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to explore Assisi on your own. Perhaps you would like to visit Piazza del Comune, Chiesa Nuova, the home and cloth workshops of Pietro Bernadone and Lady Pica (St. Francis' parents), or the home of Favorino and Ortolana Schifi (St. Clare's parents)

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Assisi.

Day 8 Monday, September 16: Orvieto I Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, as we depart Assisi, we will stop to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. After our visit we will leave Assisi for Orvieto. Orvieto stands dramatically on top of an island of volcanic rock in the middle of the Tiber Valley. Its chief attraction is the cathedral, begun in 1290 to shelter the relics of the Miracle of Bolsena (Miracle of the Host). Upon arrival, celebrate Mass at the shrine in Orvieto Cathedral. After Mass, we will have a guided tour of the magnificent 13thcentury church with its marble exterior of alternating black and white stripes. One of the side chapels contain frescoes by Luca Signorelli. Independent lunch in Orvieto. Late afternoon, we will continue to Rome, the "Eternal City." We will see 2,500 years of history, from Roman ruins to 15th-century churches, 17th-century palaces, and 20thcentury monuments. Check-in at hotel in Rome. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome.

Day 9 Tuesday, September 17: Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica I St. Paul Outside-the-Walls I Catacombs

After an early breakfast at our hotel, transfer to St. Peter's Basilica to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass, visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. See the Sistine Chapel and contemplate the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End your morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. If time permits, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Índependent lunch.

We will visit the magnificent Papal Basilica of St. Paul, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. After having been totally destroyed by fire in 1823, it was rebuilt on the original basilican plan of early Christian churches. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from Peter to Francis. Then, we will travel along the ancient Appian Way. We will see the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving Patrician tombs, including the massive tomb of Cecilia Metella. Visit the Catacombs of St. Sebastian and the Basilica of San Sebastiano fuori le mura. Walk through the maze of tunnels where early Christians secretly practiced religious rites and buried their dead. Continue to the Minor Basilica of Saint Lawrence Outside the Walls, one of the Seven Pilgrim Churches and one of Rome's oldest, housing relics of St. Lawrence, St. Justin, and St. Stephen. Here, we will have time for prayer and reflection.
Independent dinner. Overnight at hotel in Rome.

Day 10 Wednesday, September 18: Papal Audience | Major Basilicas I Farewell Dinner

After an early breakfast, we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. We will have a guided tour of one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (AD 432-440). In the nave, take in the remarkable mosaics that depict scenes from the Old Testament. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Pray near the relic of Christ's manger which came to Rome when Saint Jerome's body was brought to the church from Bethlehem. **Celebrate Mass in the** Basilica of St. Mary Major. After Mass, continue to the Basilica of St. John Lateran, dedicated to St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist, founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. End our morning tour with a visit to the Basilica of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, one of the Seven Pilgrim Churches of Rome where relics of the Passion are preserved.

Our festive farewell dinner will be at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship and taste wonderful Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music. (B,D)

Day 11 Thursday, September 19: Return from Rome

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2024, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. If you purchase independent connecting flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,195.00 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally

given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
