Our journey will continue to Chartres, the Marian shrine that houses the tunic that the Virgin Mary wore at the birth of Christ. We'll visit Mont-Saint-Michel, one of France's most stunning places of pilgrimage.

We will stop in Normandy to pray and remember those who lost their lives there, those who served our country in World War II, and those who presently serve us in the armed forces ensuring us the freedom we have today. Finally, we'll visit the most famous sites and shrines of Paris and enjoy a moonlit river cruise on the Seine, passing by the city's illuminated monuments and sparkling Eiffel Tower.

### **Day 1 Sunday, July 7: Depart USA**

Depart John F. Kennedy International Airport on Air France flight for our overseas journey to Pau, via Paris. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D)

### **Day 2 Monday, July 8: Arrive in Pau | Lourdes**

Arrive in Paris, proceed through Passport Control, and connect to our flight to Pau. Arrive at Pau-Pyrenees Airport, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager/guide as we exit Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Lourdes.

Check-in to our hotel to rest and freshen-up for dinner at the hotel restaurant.

**Evening Prayer in a chapel of the sanctuary followed by 9:00 p.m. candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor the Mother of God.** Everyone is invited to carry a lighted candle as a reminder of Baptism.

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

### **Day 3 Tuesday, July 9: Full Day in Lourdes**

Breakfast at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass at the Grotto** (subject to confirmation). *Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.*

Begin our day of pilgrimage at the sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes, doorway to the Pyrenees mountain chain. Known throughout the world, it is here that the Virgin Mary appeared to the uneducated shepherdess as the Immaculate Conception. Today the grotto of apparitions is a place of prayer for all the pilgrims who flock here, many on pilgrimages for the sick. Each person can take some water from Lourdes for himself or for a friend. Walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette and visit the places where she lived, including the Boly Mill where she grew up and the *cachot* where her family moved later on in her life. The sanctuary also offers the possibility to deepen one's relationship with the Virgin Mary. The welcoming of the sick is particularly well-organized and physical healings continue to happen. The museum of the miraculously healed and the examining office, in the confines of the sanctuary, are there to attest to the authenticity of any healings.

Independent lunch and free day for private devotions.

**Baths are open 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. / 1.30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. on weekdays.**

**The Blessed Sacrament procession is held daily at 5:00 p.m.** *During the procession there are meditations, prayers, hymns and chants in several languages. When all the participants have assembled, there follows a period of Eucharistic Adoration and the Blessing of the Sick. The Chapel of Reconciliation is open daily.* Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

**Evening Prayer in a chapel of the sanctuary followed by the 9:00 p.m. candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor the Mother of God.** Everyone is invited to carry a lighted candle as a reminder of Baptism.

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

### **Day 4 Wednesday, July 10: Lourdes | Chartres | Mont-Saint-Michel**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will be transferred to Pau-Pyrenees Airport for our continuing flight to Paris Orly Airport. Upon arrival at Paris Orly Airport, our luggage will be transferred to our tour bus and we will be on our way to visit Chartres Cathedral, also known as the Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained-glass windows. The cathedral houses the *Sancta Camisia*, a tunic that tradition says belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary. **Celebrate Mass at the cathedral.** Independent lunch.

Departure from Chartres for Mont-Saint-Michel (4-hour drive). Check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel near Mont-Saint-Michel. (B,D)

### **Day 5 Thursday, July 11: Mont-Saint-Michel | Normandy**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit Mont-Saint Michel. Stroll through this charming village with stone houses and narrow streets, built on a rock off the coast of Normandy and surrounded by one of the world's largest bays, known for its tide that "comes in with the speed of a galloping horse." **Celebrate Mass at the Abbey of Mont-Saint-Michel.** Late morning, we will depart for the Normandy coast. Independent lunch en-route.

After lunch, we will continue to Saint-Laurent-sur-Mer. We will make a poignant visit to Omaha Beach. On June 6, 1944 tens of thousands of American, English, Canadian, Scottish, and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy

coast to free France from the Nazi stronghold. Thousands of young soldiers died that first day in the name of liberty. The coast of Normandy still has the indelible scars of that event. Omaha Beach is the most famous of the Normandy landing beaches. Visit the American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer. Continue to Lisieux for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

### **Day 6 Friday, July 12: Lisieux | Giverny | Paris**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will visit the great Basilica of St. Therese of Lisieux. Learn about the life of St. Therese, Doctor of the Church, known as "The Little Flower" by the pilgrims who are drawn to her gospel simplicity. **Celebrate Mass in the Crypt Chapel.** Time will be given for prayer and reflection. Continue to visit *Les Buissonnets*, the Martin family home where St. Therese spent her childhood. Then, visit the Carmelite convent where Therese remained cloistered until her death. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we'll visit Giverny's glorious floral gardens, complete with a rainbow of blossoms, weeping willows, a Japanese footbridge, and the water lilies that inspired so many French artists, including Monet. Then, we'll continue to Paris, the "City of Lights," for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

### **Day 7 Saturday, July 13: Shrine of the Miraculous Medal | St. Vincent**

#### **DePaul | Sainte-Chapelle | Seine River Cruise**

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal at Rue de Bac. **Celebrate Mass in the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal.** This is an important place of prayer and pilgrimage that draws believers from all over the world who seek the Virgin Mary's protection. This chapel is the place where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré between July and December of 1830. Continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent DePaul, where his remains may be venerated. Next, we'll continue to the Ile de la Cité in the historic heart of Paris and see the façade of Notre Dame Cathedral, a jewel of gothic art. Continue to Sainte-Chapelle, a hidden treasure. Discover the lower part of the chapel, with its open design, and the upper part flooded with light from its huge stained-glass windows. The relic of the Crown of Thorns was originally housed here prior to its transfer to Notre Dame Cathedral.

Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore Paris on your own.

**After dinner, enjoy a special cruise on the Seine River** to see history spanning 1,000 years while passing 25 bridges and the main illuminated monuments of Paris.

Overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

### **Day 8 Sunday, July 14: Nevers**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Paris to visit Nevers (3-hour drive). Upon arrival, enjoy an independent lunch.

Our pilgrimage continues to the sanctuary of Nevers, dedicated to St. Bernadette of Lourdes. At the conclusion of the eighteen apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes, St. Bernadette lived for 13 years as a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. Reflect and pray before the intact body of St. Bernadette, preserved in a shrine in the chapel of what was known as the Convent of St. Gildard. In the same chapel is the heart of Father Thomas Price, one of the founders of Maryknoll. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After our visit we'll return to Paris.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

### **Day 9 Monday, July 15: Highlights of Paris | Montmartre**

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, our guide will bring alive the remarkable sights of this magnificent and romantic city: the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, the Opéra, Bastille Square, and the Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris and one of the most beautiful squares in the world. Continue on to Montmartre. Independent lunch.

We'll visit the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Montmartre and enjoy an amazing view of Paris from atop the hill. In 1870, war broke out between France and Germany and France was invaded. People grew to believe that that the ordeals undergone by France were due to spiritual faults rather than merely political ones. This led to the construction of a basilica dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in atonement, which became a symbol of hope and spiritual renewal. Parisian and French Christians pledged to maintain a permanent 24/7 prayer in petition for the protection of Paris. In 1872, the archbishop of Paris approved the project and chose the hill of Montmartre for the site. The edifice was financed through individual gifts (often modest ones) from people all over France. Their names are engraved in the stone of the basilica. For over a century, Parisians and pilgrims from all over the world have maintained the permanent prayer there. **Celebrate Mass at Sacred Heart Church.**

**Farewell dinner at La Bonne Franquette, French Brasserie of Montmartre.**

Overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

### **Day 10 Tuesday, July 16: Return to the USA**

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Paris CDG Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

## Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

**PAYMENT:** All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

**CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** All tour deposits are non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 100 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

**LATE RESERVATIONS:** Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2024, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. If you purchase independent connecting flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

**AIRLINE SEATING:** Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

**LAND ONLY PASSENGERS:** The Land Only package price is \$3,345.00 per person in a single room (\$150 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150.00 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. **TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Portage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$995.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and dinner daily, including a farewell dinner in Paris with wine and mineral water.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities are not included in your tour

package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.

**TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY:** Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others.
