Day 1 Tuesday, October 8: Depart USA

Depart Los Angeles International Airport on our overnight flight to Venice, Italy via Frankfurt. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

Day 2 Wednesday, October 9: Arrive in Venice | Padua

Arrive at Venice International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Padua. In Padua, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Anthony, with its famous Chapel of the Relics containing the actual tongue and lower jawbone of the saint. The basilica also contains a mixture of Gothic, Romanesque, and Byzantine architecture, holding a huge collection of art treasures. Then, we'll continue to Mestre, a suburb of Venice, for hotel check-(D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Mestre.

Day 3 Thursday, October 10: Highlights of Venice I Free Afternoon

After breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to the pier for a boat transfer to St. Mark's Square to explore this lovely and famous lagoon city on the Adriatic Coast. Begin our day with a walking tour of Venice's hub of activity, Piazza San Marco, which is lined with galleries, luxury shops, and charming cafes. Dominating the square is the magnificent St. Mark's Basilica. Celebrate Mass at St. Mark's Basilica. After Mass, enjoy a guided visit of the basilica with its shimmering mosaics, precious sculptures, and rare marble. Admire the campanile and clock tower, where Moors have been striking the hours for over 500 years. Continue to the Bridge of Sighs, which connects to the Doge's Palace and the Piombi Prisons. The bridge is so named because of the sad laments of the prisoners as they were led across it to certain torture and possible death.

Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore Venice on your own. Don't miss out on an optional gondola trip, gliding along the picturesque canals with a local troubadour to serenade you. Independent dinner in Venice. Late evening transfer back to the hotel.

Overnight at our hotel in Mestre.

Day 4 Friday, October 11: Highlights of Florence

After breakfast at our hotel, leave Mestre and drive south through the gentle Tuscan hills that for centuries have inspired saints and artists, to the Renaissance city of Florence. Check-in at our hotel in Florence. Independent lunch.

Our local guide will take us to visit the Accademia, which holds the superb sculpture of "David" by Michelangelo. Continue to the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo and the delicately patterned green, white, and pink Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, crowned with Brunelleschi's magnificent dome. See Giotto's Bell Tower and the Romanesque Baptistery of St. John, with Ghiberti's exquisite bronze doors that Michelangelo called the "Gates of Paradise." Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral or the Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross. (B.D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence.

Day 5 Saturday, October 12: Assisi | Sites of St. Francis and St. Clare Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Florence for Assisi, one of the high points of any travel experience. After a two and half-hour ride, you will see Assisi on a mountaintop: with its narrow lanes, Shrines of Saint Francis, and overwhelming art dedicated to its young friar, a rich young man who turned to God after an illness and established an order that has grown stronger over the centuries. Late morning, we'll visit the basilica complex, which is composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230, and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica. After Mass, we'll visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Independent lunch. Check-in at our hotel in Assisi. Free afternoon to explore Assisi on your own. Optional independent visits include Piazza del Comune, Chiesa Nuova, the home and cloth workshops of Pietro Bernadone and Lady Pica (St. Francis' parents), the home of St. Clare's parents, the Bishop's Palace, or the Sanctuary of the

Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. The tomb of Bl. Carlo Acutis is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to

have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Blessed

Carlo Acutis who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the

Fucharist Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi.

Day 6 Sunday, October 13: Assisi I Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. We'll visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. After Mass, we'll continue to Rome, the "Eternal City." A stop will be made for independent lunch.

Check-in at our hotel in Rome. Free afternoon in Rome. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 7 Monday, October 14: St. Peter's Basilica | Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel | Optional Scavi Tour

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass we will visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. In your free time, you may wish to return to the Vatican Crypt to pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch and free time in Rome.

Optional Scavi Tour (subject to confirmation): The Scavi, or Vatican Necropolis, is the underground excavation under St. Peter's Basilica. In 1939, Pope Pius XII ordered an excavation beneath the grotto of St. Peter's Basilica, where many popes are buried. Among the tombs of pagans and early Christians, far beneath the high altar of St. Peter's, excavators found a shrine amid the rubble. Most scholars concur that the small column is part of a second-century A.D. shrine built by Rome's small Christian community on the site where St. Peter was buried.

Free afternoon to explore Rome on your own. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

Day 8 Tuesday, October 15: Walking Tour of Rome | Imperial Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, enjoy a guided walking tour of historic Rome, beginning at the Spanish Steps (Piazza di Spagna). Continue to the Trevi Fountain to toss in a coin and then visit the Pantheon. Built more than 1800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for all the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheon, one can see the original dedication by Marcus Agrippa in Latin. Our walking tour will continue to the lively Piazza Navona. Celebrate Mass in the Church of St. Agnes. After Mass, time will be given to browse through the artists' stalls or relax and enjoy one of Rome's most famous products, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini. Independent lunch

This afternoon, we'll visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome and the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Continue to the grandiose white marble monument of King Victor Emmanuel II, often called the "Wedding Cake." See the Trajan Column and the Market (the ancient Roman equivalent of a department store). (B)

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

Day 9 Wednesday, October 16: Papal Audience I St. Paul Outside-the-

Walls | Catacombs | Farewell Dinner

After an early breakfast, enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

Independent lunch followed by a unique tour of Rome and her outskirts. Visit the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from St. Peter to Francis. Then, we'll drive along a section of the Old Appian Way, one of the first ancient Roman military roads that connected Rome to Naples and Brindisi on the Adriatic coast. We can see the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving Patrician tombs that once lined its way, including the massive tomb of Cecilia Metella. We will visit the Catacombs, the maze of tunnels hollowed out of volcanic rock where early Christians-persecuted by the Romans-secretly practiced their religious rites and buried their dead. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul or the Catacombs.

Our farewell dinner will be at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music. Overnight at our hotel in Rome.
