DAY 1 Monday, September 23: Depart USA

Depart Dallas DFW International Airport on British Airways for Austria. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 <u>Tuesday, September 24: Welcome to Vienna!</u>

This afternoon, arrive at Vienna International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim your luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Vienna, the Music Capital of the World! Vienna is the city of Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Strauss! We will stay for three nights in Vienna. Hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B,D

DAY 3 <u>Wednesday, September 25: Imperial Vienna | Schonbrunn Palace</u>

Breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll see the most important historical sights of Vienna. **Celebrate Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral.** After Mass, we'll tour the Cathedral. Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice houses a wealth of art treasures and is dedicated to St. Stephen, the first martyr of Christendom. Then, continue our orientation tour as we pass by the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; the Capuchin Church, which contain the imperial vaults; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing the Vienna Opera, Museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. Independent lunch.

We will have an extended tour of the Schonbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the Habsburgs. The name comes from the fountain that was built over a spring in the early 1600's. It came into its full grandiose incarnation during the reign of Maria Theresa, when she added the massive mirrors, frescoed ceilings, and gigantic crystal chandeliers. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore the famous Karntnerstrase, view Mozart's memorial; walk along Kaerntner strasse, a pedestrian area where glamorous stores line the sidewalks; take a ride in a horse-drawn coach; or wander along the winding streets of the old city with architecture reminiscent of past centuries.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, September 26: Melk Abbey | Danube River Cruise Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Vienna on our excursion to Melk. Enjoy magnificent scenery along the Danube in a region known as the Wachau, the pride of the historic preservation movement in Austria. At Melk, we will visit the Benedictine Abbey, crowning the rocky hill overlooking the Danube. Its library contains over 80,000 books and 2,000 manuscripts, all on religious subjects. Celebrate Mass at the Abbey. Independent lunch.

Embark on a 90-minute Danube River Cruise. We will pass the Schönbühel Castle and the town of Dürnstein with its blue tower. Disembark in the picturesque Krems an der Donau. We will enjoy some leisure time before returning back to Vienna.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

DAY 5 Salzburg Friday, September 27: Shrine of Mariazell | Lake District |

Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we'll leave Vienna and drive across the spectacular forested mountains, rushing streams, and small market towns to the little village of Mariazell, a favorite Viennese resort. Visit the Shrine of Mariazell. The shrine is a famous pilgrimage center in Austria dedicated to the Blessed Mother. A monk, who built a small shelter or

"Zell" in the woods to protect a statue of the Blessed Mother, founded the shrine in 1157. Today Mariazell Baroque church has been rebuilt several times in different architectural styles and still houses the old statue. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Mariazell.** Independent lunch. This afternoon, we'll leave Mariazell and drive through the Austrian Lake District, with marvelous views of the Salzkammergut region, to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

DAY 6 Saturday, September 28: Highlights of Salzburg | Hallein Salt Mines

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the Shrine of Maria Plain in Salzburg. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. In 1633, a painting of the Blessed Mother was found undamaged in the ruins of a totally burned wooden house. In 1656, a small wooden chapel was built at this location and in 1710, the chapel was rebuilt to house the first copy of the miraculous image. In 1951, Pope Pius XII, conferred the title of this Shrine to "Basilica Minor." Then we'll begin our guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings. Pass by the house where Mozart was born and view Monchsberg with the fortress "Hohensalzburg," which overlooks the city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the dynamic sculpture of the Residenzbrunnen, the largest baroque fountain north of the Alps. The Residenz building, built in 1596, was once the palace of bishops. Next, visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery where the escape was filmed in The Sound of Music and where most of Mozart's religious works were premiered.

This afternoon, we'll enjoy a visit to the famous salt mines in the Celtic town of Hallein, where we'll wear a miner's smock and descend to the levels below on long wooden slides. It's both fun and enlightening. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

DAY 7 Sunday, September 29: Neuschwanstein Castle

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Salzburg for Munich. **Enroute we'll stop at the Benedictine Abbey of Ettal or the Weiskirche for Mass.** Independent lunch.

We'll explore King Ludwig's majestic castle, Neuschwanstein. This dream-like fortress was built on 1869 based on sketches of a theatrical decorator. Return to the times of Wagner as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas; the throne rooms and music halls, with fine candelabras and chandeliers; King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings; and an artificial grotto that recalls opera themes of his former friend and composer Richard Wagner. After our visit we'll continue to Munich for check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Munich. (B,D)

DAY 8 Monday, September 30: Highlights of Munich | Oktoberfest Breakfast at our hotel. This morning our local guide will take us to explore the highlights of Munich, including the Marienplatz and world-famous Glockenspiel; the twin-towered Frauenkirche, the most familiar landmark of old Munich; town hall; and the royal boulevard with its triumphal arch and victory gate. Celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady (Frauenkirche). Independent lunch.

Mid-day Oktoberfest Session (3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.) Tent reservations are subject to confirmation. A confirmed tent reservation will include two large beers and a traditional food plate for each guest. If confirmed, your actual seating time will be finalized approximately 5 - 10 days prior to your reservation date.

Return to the hotel to pack for our early return flight on Tuesday.

Overnight at our hotel in Munich.

DAY 9 Tuesday, October 1: Return to the USA

Early morning, we will be transferred to Munich Airport for our return flight to Dallas DFW International Airport.

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping. price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. Payment for CFAR must be included with your deposit at the time of enrollment. CFÁR coverage cannot be purchased by New York State residents as per state law.
