# DAY 1 Monday, April 21: Depart USA

This evening, depart New York JFK International Airport for our flight to Paris, France. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the flight.

# DAY 2 <u>Tuesday, April 22: Arrive in Paris | Lisieux</u>

Arrive at Paris CDG International Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our tour bus and we will be on our way to Lisieux (threehour bus ride). Independent lunch upon arrival.

We'll visit "Les Buissonnets," the home where Thérèse Martin spent eleven years of her life until she joined the Carmelite Convent. Continue to the Carmelite Convent of Lisieux. When Thérèse Martin entered the convent on April 9, 1888, there were 26 sisters. They prayed together for six and a half hours every day, two hours of which were spent in contemplative prayer. Celebrate Mass in the Convent Chapel. Venerate the remains of St. Thérèse in the Chapel of the Reliquary. Some of her remains have been inserted into the figure that represents her on her death bed. Continue to our hotel in Lisieux for check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux.

DAY 3 Wednesday, April 23: Caen | Normandy Landing Beaches Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Thérèse, where we will celebrate Mass in the Crypt Chapel. After Mass, we'll have a guided visit of the astonishing Basilica of St. Thérèse and the Crypt. Continue to the 13th century Gothic Norman Cathedral of St. Peter, where St. Thérèse attended Mass every Sunday for more than 10 years. Continue to Caen to visit the Visitation Convent. Visit the chapel where the reliquary of the Servant of God Sister Françoise-Thérése Léonie Martin was placed in her new tomb. Continue to visit the Caen-Normandy Memorial. Located in the immediate vicinity of the D-Day landing beaches, the memorial visitor center focuses on the Battle of Normandy and 20th century history. Independent lunch. Continue to the Normandy Landing Beaches and stop at Omaha Beach. On June 6, 1944, tens of thousands of English, Canadian, American, Scottish, and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy coast to liberate France from the Nazi stronghold. Continue to the American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux.

# DAY 4 Thursday, April 24: Alençon | Chartres | Paris

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Lisieux to visit the town of Alençon. We'll visit the birthplace of St. Thérèse at the Martin family home on Rue Saint-Blaise in Alençon. See a glimpse of the family life of her parents, Saints Louis and Zelie Martin, and their children at Alençon. Other visits include the Basilica of Our Lady where they were married. Thérèse's parents were devout, energetic, and loving. Her mother established a business manufacturing point d'Alençon lace. Thérèse had four older sisters: Marie, Pauline, Leonie, and Celine. Several years after little Thérèse was born, Zelie developed breast cancer. After a painful illness, she died on August 28, 1877. After his wife's death, Louis Martin decided to leave Alençon and move with his children to Lisieux, where Zelie's brother and sister-in-law, Isidore and Celine Guerin, could offer an extended family to his daughters. Celebrate

# Mass in the Martin home chapel.

Independent lunch.

We'll visit Chartres and Notre Dame Cathedral. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe's most impressive collections of stained-glass windows. The Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres also houses the Sancta Camisia, a tunic that according to tradition belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Continue to Paris for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

# DAY 5 Friday, April 25: Pilgrim Churches of Paris | Montmartre

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Rue de Bac, Shrine of the Miraculous Medal. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. This is where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in 1830. Continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent DePaul, where his saintly remains are preserved and venerated. Next, we'll go to lle de la Cité, where we will see the exterior of the magnificent cathedral, Notre-Dame-de-Paris. Its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows will take your breath away. Continue to visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of Flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité. Discover its unique stained-glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the Heavenly Jerusalem. Independent lunch.

We'll experience the remarkable sights of this magnificent and romantic city on the River Seine: the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triômphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, the Opéra, Bastille Square, and the Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris. Continue to Montmartre to visit Sacré Coeur Basilica de Montmartre (Sacred Heart of Montmartre), located at the summit of the hill of Montmartre, on the right bank of the Seine. In 1870, war broke out between France and Germany, and France was invaded. The idea took hold that the ordeals incurred by France were due to its spiritual faults as well as its political ones. This gave birth to the construction of a basilica dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Parisian and French Christians pledged to maintain perpetual prayer in exchange for the protection of Paris. In 1872, the archbishop of Paris approved the project and chose the hill of Montmartre for the site.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

### DAY 6 Saturday, April 26: Paris | Lourdes

Early breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll be transferred to the airport for our continuing flight to Lourdes. We'll have a brief orientation tour of the Lourdes Sanctuary domain, including the Basilica of St. Pius X, Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, Crypt, and Grotto. Independent lunch.

Check-in at our hotel. Celebrate Mass at one of the chapels in Lourdes. Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

#### At 9:30 p.m., participate in praying the Rosary in the Chapel of the Apparitions, followed by a Candlelight Procession. (B,D)

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

# DAY / Sunday, April 27: Lourdes Sanctuary | Walking Tour

Breakfast at our hotel. Celebrate Mass at the Grotto (to be confirmed. Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.)

After Mass, we'll embark on a walking tour of Lourdes and visit places associated with the life of young Bernadette. The places include the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch.

This afternoon is free for private devotions.

#### Rosary at the Grotto at 3:00 p.m. Eucharistic Procession at 5:00 p.m.

The Chapel of Reconciliation is open daily.

At 9:00 p.m., join the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor the **Mother of God.** In addition to all the pilgrims from around the world, each night the entire town of Lourdes seems to descend on the Sanctuary. After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to the airport for our return flight home via Paris.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip estimated economy class airfare from New York. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability.
