DAY 1 Wednesday, June 25: Depart for Italy

Depart Jacksonville International Airport on our overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D)

DAY 2 Thursday, June 26: Arrive in Rome | Sorrento

Late morning, arrive to Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way south on the Autostrada del Sol, "Sun Route," via the regions of Lazio and Campania, to Sorrento. Independent lunch en-route.

Late afternoon, we'll arrive in the Sorrento region for check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Castellammare di Stabia. (B,D)

DAY 3 Friday, June 27: Positano | Amalfi Coast

Breakfast at our hotel. Today the group will be split into minibuses to visit the Amalfi towns. From Sorrento, we'll take a spectacular drive as we visit the Amalfi towns of Positano and Amalfi, where we'll enjoy a remarkable bird's-eye view of Positano, commanding a beautiful view of the Gulf of Naples. Visit the Cathedral of St. Andrew the Apostle in Amalfi. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral.** Independent lunch in the town of Amalfi.

Then, we'll continue to visit the Amalfi towns of Ravello, Minori, Maiori, Vietri Sul Mare, and Salerno.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Castellammare di Stabia. (B,D)

DAY 4 Saturday, June 28: Pompeii | Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we'll explore the well-preserved remains of the ancient Roman town of Pompeii, where all life was suddenly stopped by an eruption of Vesuvius in the year 79 A.D. The volcano collapsed higher roof-lines and buried Pompeii under 60 feet of ash and pumice. It was lost for nearly 1700 years before its accidental rediscovery in 1748. Since then, its excavation has provided an extraordinarily detailed insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire. Today, it is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Italy.

Possible visit to the Cathedral and the Shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mass of the Rosary in Pompeii. Independent lunch.

Drive north to Rome, the "Eternal City." A stop will be made en route for a independent light dinner. Continue to Rome and check-in at our hotel upon arrival.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 5 Sunday, June 29: Solemnity of Ss. Peter and Paul | Tour of Imperial Rome

After early breakfast at our hotel, we'll be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to attend the Papal Mass on the Solemnity of Ss. Peter and Paul, celebrated by His Holiness Pope Francis. After Mass, attend the noon Papal Blessing in St. Peter's Square. Independent lunch.

We'll begin our day with a visit to the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome. In the same church, we'll also see the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Then, we'll continue to the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Continue to the grandiose white marble monument of King Victor Emmanuel II, often called the "Wedding Cake." See Trajan's Column and the Market (the ancient Roman equivalent of a department store).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 6 Monday, June 30: Tour of the Papal Basilicas of Rome | Concert Presentation at the Basilica of the Apostles

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, begin our day with a visit to the

magnificent Basilica of St. Paul. The basilica was built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. After being destroyed by fire in 1823, it was rebuilt on the original plan of early Christian churches. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from Peter to Benedict XVI. Continue our tour to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by the emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the Popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 AD). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Independent lunch. Return to our hotel to freshen-up.

After an early dinner, we will be transferred to the Basilica of the Apostles for a formal concert for the City of Rome, presented by St. Joseph Church Choir.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 7 Tuesday, July 1: Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel | St. Peter's Basilica

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, **we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence.** Begin our day of sightseeing with a visit to one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Continue to the Sistine Chapel, the private chapel of the popes, where Michelangelo best expressed his genius in monumental frescoes. End our morning tour in St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the new tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. On your own, with time permitting, you may wish to go to the Vatican Crypt to see and pray near the tomb of St. Peter, where numerous pontiffs including Pope Benedict VI, are buried among incredible works of art.

Free afternoon to explore the sights, sounds, and tastes of Rome all on your own! Perhaps you'll buy religious articles in preparation for the Papal Blessing at the audience on Wednesday. Or treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. Visit the Colosseum or the beautiful and lively Piazza Navona, with time to browse through the artists' stalls to buy a painting and sample one of Rome's most famous products, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini. This is the time to visit the local shops and street vendors. Rome is yours!

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 8 Wednesday, July 2: Papal Audience | Sung Solemn Mass at St. Peter's Basilica | Farewell Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. After an early breakfast, **enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet all the pilgrims present, deliver his message to the faithful, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Choirs should be prepared to sing a brief song of greeting if the Holy Father draws near as he passes through the crowd.** Independent lunch.

Around 4:00 p.m., **we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica for the 5:00 p.m. Solemn Mass, sung by St. Joseph Church Choir.** There will be a photo opportunity after Mass.

Our farewell dinner will be at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 9 Thursday, July 3: Return from Rome

After breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour deposits and payments are non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: The travel package does not include airfare. Optional group airfare from Jacksonville will be offered as an add-on once a group booking and airfare have been confirmed. Flight itinerary and carrier to be advised in May 2024. You will have 3 to 5 days to either accept or decline the group airfare offering. If you choose to purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible if you cancel your participation in the tour for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.** PLEASE NOTE, under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. If you choose to purchase the group airfare, requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you book your airline arrangements independently.

LAND ONLY TOUR PRICE: The Land Only package price is \$3,495.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently if the group airfare add-on is declined. Passenger(s) who purchase airfare independently, or deviate from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group booking arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Group airfare deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the land only package plus the group airfare add-on for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$895 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: European breakfast daily plus five (5) dinners, including a farewell dinner with wine and entertainment at a restaurant in Rome.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service

charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
