DAY 1 Saturday, June 28: Depart for Vienna

Depart Newark or Miami for Vienna, Austria. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Sunday, June 29: Arrive in Vienna | Orientation Tour

Arrive at Vienna International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Continuo Arts/Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs.

Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Vienna. As it is unlikely the hotel rooms will be available, we'll enjoy an orientation tour of Vienna. Pass the Karlskirche (Church of St. Charles), considered the most outstanding baroque church in Vienna, and Belvedere Palace, former summer residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Vienna Ring Road, located on sites where medieval city fortifications once stood. We'll pass the Vienna Opera, Museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. (Orientation tour depends on flight arrival time.)

Check-in at our hotel in Vienna and freshen-up. Afternoon rehearsal time to be advised.

Welcome dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (D)

DAY 3 Monday, June 30: Highlight Tour of Vienna | Concert Presentation at Peterskirsche | Evening Cruise to Melk

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll visit St. Stephen's Cathedral (Stephansdom), Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice and mother church of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna. Famous for its multi-colored tile roof, Stephansdom is one of the city's most recognizable symbols. After our visit, we'll have a walking tour as we pass by Hofburg Imperial Palace, former residence of the imperial family; the Capuchin Church containing the Imperial Crypt, the Broque Church of St. Peter's (Peterskiche); and the die Wiener Pestsaule or Holy Trinity Column. Independent lunch

Wiener Pestsaule, or Holy Trinity Column. Independent lunch. **We'll be transferred to Peterskirche for a 30-minute concert presentation by the Continuo Arts Symphonic Chorus.** After the concert, we'll be transferred to Vienna Pier to board the MS Beethoven. After comfortably settling into our cabins, meet the crew for a welcome cocktail. Our ship will depart at 8:00 p.m. for Melk and sail through the night. Dinner and overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,D)

DAY 4 Tuesday, July 1: Melk | Dürnstein

After breakfast, depart by coach for Melk Abbey. The abbey overlooking the Danube was first built as the Babenberg's fortified castle. It was founded in the 11th century and the current buildings of the Benedictine abbey date from the Baroque era, designed by architect Jakob Prandtauer. Melk Abbey now houses a museum in which computer animations tell a story about the construction of the edifices. You will also visit the marble hall, the world-famous library, and the bedchambers where a number of illustrious visitors have slept. **20-minute informal concert at the Abbey, presented by Continuo Arts Symphonic Chorus.**

Return on board. We'll cruise up the beautiful Wachau Valley all the way to Dürnstein, passing gothic ruins and picturesque villages along the way. Once we arrive, we'll take a tour of this charming medieval town with our hostess. We'll return on board at the end of the afternoon and continue cruising towards Bratislava. All meals on board. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 <u>Wednesday</u>, July 2: Bratislava | Kalocsa, Hungary

After breakfast, we'll tour Bratislava, the capital of independent Slovakia. Enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, which will take us to see the exterior of Bratislava Castle, which dates from 1811, after the previous castle burned down. From here we will enjoy a breathtaking view over the Danube and the city. The main historical monuments are in the Old Town and the coach will drop us off at its entrance to continue the visit on foot. We will enter through Michael's Gate, which is the only gate still surviving from the Middle Ages. Then we will head for the central square surrounded by elegant buildings, some in Art Nouveau style, and dominated by the old Bratislava Town Hall. The tour continues to see the exterior of the Primate's Palace, completed in 1781 for Archbishop Jozef Bathyány. As we stroll through the streets, we may come across some of the amusing statues that are dotted around the capital. After the guided tour, we will have some free time before returning on board. We'll cruise to Kalocsa. All meals on board. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 Thursday, July 3: Lajosmizse | Budapest

After breakfast, we'll depart by coach for Lajosmizse and the Puszta. Riding

aboard a charabanc (a traditional horse-drawn carriage with wooden benches) we'll be amazed by the wonderful landscapes and unusual fauna of the Puszta. In a small part of the Hungarian Steppe, we'll get to observe Racka sheep with their spiral-shaped horns, Mangalica pigs with their curly coats, and Hungarian Grey cattle with their long, curved horns, as well as rare species of birds. During your visit, we'll get the chance to attend a traditional horse show while tasting* "palinka" (plum eau-de-vie) and some "pogacsa" (small savory buns). The csikós, the mounted horse-herdsmen of Hungary dressed in traditional blue attire, will invite us to take part in their "games of skill and ability."

For lunch, we'll taste local specialties served in a "czardas" (a traditional tavern) surrounded by Hungarian musicians. Afterwards, we'll set out for a visit of Kecskemét on foot. Located in the central part of Hungary, the city shelters various Fine Arts institutes. Several of its buildings have given the city its fame. We'll admire the Cifrapalota, a palace in Rococo-style, ornate with colorful patterns and flowers, that is today home to the Kecskemét Art Gallery. We'll see the impressive City Hall, the former Synagogue that was turned into an office building by the Soviets, and more. Return on board.

We'll spend the evening cruising towards Budapest. All meals are included. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 Friday, July 4: Budapest

After breakfast, we will leave for a panoramic tour of Budapest, the Pearl of the Danube. First we will head for the hills of Buda by crossing the Elizabeth Bridge and go up to the Castle quarter, from where we'll enjoy a fantastic panoramic view of the city. We will walk around the castle quarter and on to the Fisherman's Bastion, built in neo-Roman style in 1902 to offer a panoramic view over the city and the Danube. Behind the Bastion, we will find Matthias Church, which notably was the venue for the coronation of Emperor Franz Joseph and his wife "Sissi." Our coach will then take us down to the plains of Pest. There, we will visit Heroes' Square, whose central monument depicting Prince Arpad and the chieftains of seven Magyar tribes was built for the millennium of Hungary. We will pass by the famous Szechenyi thermal baths, the zoo, Vajdahunyad Castle, and more. We will walk through the famous Andrassy Avenue and pass by St. Stephen's Basilica, whose construction began in 1851 and was completed in 1905. We will walk along the river and see the famous Parliament building overlooking the Danube with its white silhouette in Byzantine and neo-Gothic style. We'll

be transferred to St. Stephen's Cathedral or Matthias Church for a concert presentation by the Continuo Arts Symphonic Chorus.

Evening of traditional entertainment in Budapest (option not included).

All meals on board. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 Saturday, July 5: Esztergom | Vienna

Once we arrive, enjoy some free time in Esztergom, one of the oldest cities in Hungary. The afternoon will be spent cruising to Vienna. **Tonight is our gala evening.** Our ship will sail through the night. All meals on board. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 Sunday, July 6: Vienna

After breakfast, we'll have a tour of the high art of Viennese living: music and Viennese cafes. We'll stroll through the city and visit backstage in the Konzerthaus concert hall. After our tour, enjoy a steaming cup of Viennese coffee and a delicious pastry.

Drive around the famous Ring to visit Schönbrunn Palace. The Ring was one of the personal projects of Emperor Franz Joseph. In 1857, he decided to take down the ramparts that enclosed the city center and had this boulevard built, lined with fine buildings. Along the Ring we will admire this architectural showcase of the old Austro-Hungarian monarchy, including the State Opera, Hofburg Palace, Natural History Museum, City Hall; the Burgtheater, and more. When we arrive at Schönbrunn Palace, we will be guided through the numerous rooms of the Hapsburgs' summer residence, which bear witness to the splendor of the court at the time of Maria Theresa. We will also have some time to wander through the palace gardens. Late afternoon 30-minute concert presentation at Schönbrunn Palace, presented by the Continuo Arts Symphonic Chorus. Then, we'll return to

the coach, which will take us back to the boat, via the Ring. In the evening, join us on an optional excursion to attend a concert of

Viennese music (option not included). All meals on board. Overnight on board the MS Beethoven. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 Monday, July 7: Return from Vienna

After breakfast, disembark the MS Beethoven, and we will be transferred to Vienna Airport for our return flight to the USA.

Acceptance of these <u>Terms & Conditions</u>, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.
