DAY 1 Tuesday, September 9: Depart for Italy

Depart New York's JFK International Airport (or home gateway) for Milan. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the flight.

DAY 2 Wednesday, September 10: Welcome to Milan | Highlights of Milan

Arrive at Milan Malpensa Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager as we exit Customs. Board our comfortable private touring bus, and we will be on our way to Milan, the commercial capital of Northern Italy. Our orientation tour of Milan will pass by the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, La Scala Opera House, the Pinacoteca, and Sforzesco Castle. Continue on to visit Milan Cathedral, the Duomo, dedicated to St. Mary of the Nativity (Santa Maria Nascente). The cathedral is the city's centerpiece and fourth largest church in Europe. The interior of the cathedral includes inspiring monuments and works of art. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica.** Continue to our hotel to check-in. **Evening Prayer.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Milan. (D)

DAY 3 Thursday, September 11: Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie | Turin

Breakfast at our hotel. **Morning Prayer.** Begin our day with a visit to the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. In this beautiful old Renaissance building, we will see Leonardo da Vinci's *The Last Supper* (subject to confirmation). If confirmation for a group visit cannot be obtained to see *The Last Supper*, we will visit Sforzesco Castle instead. After our visit, we will continue to Turin. Independent lunch upon arrival in Turin.

Visit the Duomo of St. John the Baptist for a tour about the history of the holy shroud and an opportunity to see a replica of the shroud. According to tradition, the 14-foot by 4-foot linen cloth is the burial shroud of Jesus. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral.** Return to Milan. **Evening Prayer.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Milan. (B,D)

DAY 4 Friday, September 12: Highlights of Florence

Breakfast at our hotel. **Morning Prayer.** This morning, we will leave Milan and drive to the Renaissance city of Florence. Independent lunch upon arrival in Florence. Our local guide will take us to visit the Accademia, which houses the sculpture of David by Michelangelo. Then continue to the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo to see the delicately patterned green, white, and pink Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, crowned with Brunelleschi's magnificent dome. See Giotto's Bell Tower; the Romanesque Baptistery of St. John with Ghiberti's exquisite bronze, called the "Gates of Paradise" by Michelangelo; and the 13th century Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross, which holds tombs of the greatest Florentine citizens. **Celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Church of the Holy Cross.** After our visits, check-in at our hotel. **Evening Prayer.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Florence. (B,D)

DAY 5 Saturday, September 13: Assisi | Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare

Breakfast at our hotel. **Morning Prayer.** This morning, we will leave Florence for Assisi. Upon arrival, we will **celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis.** After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The basilica is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. The upper basilica contains monumental frescoes depicting scenes from the life of the saint by Giotto. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare to view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Independent lunch and hotel check-in. Free afternoon to explore Assisi on your own.

You may want to visit the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis in a sanctuary located where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and whose canonization is scheduled for sometime during this Jubilee Year of 2025. **Evening Prayer.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

DAY 6 Sunday, September 14: Assisi | Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. **Morning Prayer.** This morning, we will visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, which encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula" or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the

spot where the saint died. We will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli.** After Mass, we will leave Assisi for Rome. If time permits, arrive in St. Peter's Square for the Noon Papal Blessing. Independent lunch. Check-in at our hotel. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Rome on your own. Perhaps visit the beautiful and lively Piazza Navona, with time to browse through the artists' stalls to buy a painting and sample one of Rome's most famous products, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini. You may want to visit the Church of Sant' Agnese in Agone or the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi to see the stunning interior, home to a trio of Caravaggio masterpieces. **Evening Prayer.** Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 7 Monday, September 15: The Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica | Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel

After early breakfast, we will visit St. Peter's Basilica. **Morning Prayer.** Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. **Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter** (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass, we will visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent *Pietà*. Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. In your free time, you may wish to return to the Vatican Crypt to pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore the sights, sounds, and tastes of Rome on your own! Perhaps you will buy religious articles in preparation for the Papal Blessing at the audience on Wednesday or treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. Visit the Colosseum or the Trevi Fountain and Piazza di Spagna. This is the time to visit local shops and street vendors. **Evening Prayer.** Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 8 Tuesday, September 16: Basilica of St. Clement | Castel Gandolfo | Festive Dinner

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of San Clement. Emperors, martyrs, saints, and invaders punctuate its 2,000-year history. An extraordinary cast of characters and unexpected turns of events each left its mark on the passage of Rome, from its pagan origins to its Christian flowering. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Clement.** After Mass, we'll continue to Castelli Romani in the Lazio region to visit Castel Gandolfo, the summer residence of the pope. Enjoy the attractive hilltop town dominated by the Papal Palace and the extensive gardens. We'll take a private tour of the gardens, observatory, and Papal Museum. This afternoon, we'll enjoy a wine tasting of the region and **festive meal at Cantine Santa Benedetta.** Experience warm hospitality and taste wonderful Mediterranean cuisine in a Roman setting. Upon our return to Rome, a stop will be made at the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 9 Wednesday, September 17: Papal Audience | Papal Basilicas of Rome

After an early breakfast and **Morning Prayer** at our hotel, we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Leo XIV will greet all the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch. One distinction of Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" that is opened only during Jubilee years. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (A.D. 432-440). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon *Salus Populi Romani*, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.** Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. After our visit, we will continue to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. After being destroyed by fire in 1823, it was rebuilt on the original basilican plan of early Christian churches. Surrounding the nave are medallions of each pope, from St. Peter to Pope Francis. St. Paul is buried in the confessorio of this church. Above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom. These chains were placed in this prominent location in 2008. The main altar in the left transept is dedicated to the Conversion of St. Paul. The painting above this altar, completed by Vincenzo Camuccini, depicts this event. The tabernacle of the confessorio by Arnolfo di Cambio, an exquisite 12th-century candelabra by Vassalletto, a 13th century Byzantine-style apse mosaic of Christ Pantokrator, and an attractive 19th century series of Papal Portraits are in a frieze extending around the nave. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 10 Thursday, September 18: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$500.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: A group booking will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,495.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,595.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus six (6) dinners, including wine tasting and festive dinner at Cantine Santa Benedetta. All dinners include two glasses of wine and mineral water.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for

your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. A traveler who requires special assistance must notify PWT and must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. PWT shall not be held responsible if we are unable to accommodate passengers with special needs, or for the denial of services to a passenger by any carrier, hotel, restaurant, or other independent suppliers.
