DAY 1 Saturday, September 13: Depart the USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport (or home gateway) for Poland. Dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight from Chicago.

DAY 2 Sunday, September 14: Arrive in Warsaw

Upon arrival at Warsaw International Airport, meet our Polish tour manager for an orientation tour. We'll visit St. Stanislaw Kostka Church, the national shrine of Bl. Jerzy Popieluszko, martyr for the faith. **Celebrate Mass.** After Mass, visit his grave located outside the church. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

DAY 3 Monday, September 15: Warsaw

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at St. James Convent**, where St. Faustina entered the Monastery. After receiving direction from the Lord in Lodz's Cathedral, St. Faustina arrived at this church on the outskirts of Warsaw, where the priest directed her to the home of a Catholic woman for lodging. During her stay with the Lipzye family, Faustina discerned her religious vocation with the Congregation of the Sisters of our Lady of Mercy on Zytnia Street. Enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour of Poland's capital. We will explore the Old Town, painstakingly rebuilt after World War II, with its charming little streets and cafes. Tour highlights include the royal castle and Warsaw Ghetto. Independent lunch. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

DAY 4 Tuesday, September 16: Excursion to Niepokalanów

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave on a full-day excursion to Niepokalanów, where St. Maximilian Kolbe initiated the "City of the Immaculata," dedicated to the movement of Marian Consecration. By 1939, the city had expanded from eighteen friars to an incredible 650, making it the largest Catholic religious house in the world. Our visits include the basilica, museum, St. Maximilian Kolbe's room, the cemetery, and the Kolbe Archives Tour. **Celebrate Mass at the Monastery of the Immaculata e Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe in 1927. Independent lunch. Return to Warsaw. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

DAY 5 Wednesday, September 17: Pabianice | Zduńska Wola | Częstochowa

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Warsaw to visit Pabianice, where around the time of his first Communion, Raymond received a vision of the Virgin Mary that changed his life. Visit the small church dedicated to St. Matthew (near the Kolbe family home), where Raymond experienced the vision of the Immaculata bearing two crowns. **Celebrate Mass at St. Matthew Church.** After our visit we'll continue to visit Zduńska Wola, a small village and the birthplace of Maximilian Kolbe. Independent lunch. Continue to Częstochowa. **At 9 p.m., participate in "The Call of Jasna Góra" in the Chapel of the Miraculous Image.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Częstochowa. (B,D)

DAY 6 Thursday, September 18: Jasna Góra Monastery | Oświęcim

At 6:00 a.m., witness the unveiling of the miraculous image, followed by Mass. Return to our hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, enjoy a guided visit of the monastery. We will also visit the beautiful Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Nativity of Mary, with its magnificent Baroque altar depicting the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven. Tour the monastery's museum, which houses offerings from the prisoners of Nazi and communist concentration camps. The treasury houses many votive offerings left by pilgrims, including those given to the monastery by Pope St. John Paul II. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we'll continue to the town of Oświęcim and visit the St. Maximilian Kolbe center in Harmeze. Check-in at our hotel in Oświęcim. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Oświęcim. (B,D)

DAY 7 Friday, September 19: Auschwitz | Birkenau Museum | Wadowice | Krakow

Early breakfast at our hotel. **At 8:00 a.m., group prayer at the cell of St. Maximilian Kolbe.** This morning, we'll visit Auschwitz and the Birkenau Museum. The Auschwitz Birkenau State Museum is a museum on the site of the Auschwitz concentration camp in Oświęcim, Poland. The site includes the main concentration camp at Auschwitz I and the remains of the concentration and extermination camp at Auschwitz II-Birkenau. Independent lunch. We'll continue to Wadowice, hometown of St. John Paul II, born Karol Józef Wojtyła on May 18, 1920. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Presentation of the Virgin Mary**, where Karol Wojtyła was baptized. We'll visit the museum of St. John Paul II, recently renovated and reopened. The museum tells the story of the greatest of the Poles, from his early years in the small multicultural town of Wadowice until his last days as a Bishop of Rome. Late afternoon, we'll continue to Krakow for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 8 Saturday, September 20: Highlights of Krakow

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a guided tour of Krakow, starting at the majestic castle on Wawel Hill. Walk through the beautiful renaissance courtyard and visit the famous **Wawel Cathedral, where we celebrate Mass**, burial place of all but one of the Polish kings. Enjoy Krakow's historic architecture as we make our way to see the Town Hall, Collegium Maius (the ancient building of Jagiellonian University), the Cloth Hall, and Saint Mary's Church, with the famous Wit Stwos'z' altar. We will also see Florian's Gate and the Barbican, the showpiece of the city's medieval defensive walls. Independent lunch. Enjoy a panoramic tour of Nowa Huta, Krakow district built after II World War with Mogila Abbey, a Cistercian monastery founded in 1222. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 9 Sunday, September 21: Divine Mercy Shrine | Saint John Paul II Center

Breakfast at our hotel. Visit the Divine Mercy Shrine in Lągowie. One of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy will meet with our group. We will have a guided tour of the shrine, pray near the image of Divine Mercy, and venerate St. Faustina's relics. **Celebrate Mass at the Divine Mercy Shrine.** Continue to the Saint John Paul II Center. See the octagonal lower church and Chapel of the Relics (Kosciol Relikwii), decorated with images depicting events from the pontificate of Saint John Paul II and his visits to Marian shrines around the world. Independent lunch. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 10 Monday, September 22: St. Francis Church | Wieliczka

Breakfast at our hotel. **Begin our day with Mass at the Church of St. Francis of Assisi.** After Mass, we'll visit the Monastery. Saint Maximilian Kolbe was a monk here in 1919 and led his first service at this church. After our visit we'll continue to visit Wieliczka, the oldest salt mine in Europe. Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore Krakow on your own. Farewell dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 11 Tuesday, September 23: Return to the USA

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll be transferred to Krakow Airport for our return flights to the USA. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Polish zloty valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$500.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2025, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Chicago. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure if at least 10 participants are interested in airfare from each gateway. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The estimated Land Only package price is \$2,995.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$795.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily. All dinners include mineral water and wine or beer.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend the equivalent of \$5.00 per

person per day for your tour manager; \$2.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave the equivalent of \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. A traveler who requires special assistance must notify PWT and must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. PWT shall not be held responsible if we are unable to accommodate passengers with special needs, or for the denial of services to a passenger by any carrier, hotel, restaurant, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage, or trip interruption. We also strongly suggest that you purchase the Cancel For Any Reason upgrade in order to cover your travel investment for unforeseen circumstances that are not covered by PWT as noted above under DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITY. PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide.
