While every pilgrimage brings the opportunity for its share of graces, traveling the road together makes such journeys even more enjoyable. We will entrust our time together to the maternal protection of our dear Lady of Częstochowa, in imitation of the great Saint John Paul II. We will also have an opportunity to reflect on lives of heroic holiness in Polish saints such as St. Maximilian Kolbe and St. Faustina.

We'll visit Warsaw, following in the footsteps of St. Faustina, and Niepokalanów, where St. Maximilian Kolbe initiated the "City of the Immaculate." Our pilgrimage will take us to Częstochowa's Jasna Góra Monastery and the Chapel of the Miraculous Icon of the Black Madonna, as well as the former concentration camp of Auschwitz, the site of martyrdom for St. Maximilian Kolbe. We'll proceed to Kraków, where Fr. Karol Wojtyła began his life as a priest and offered his first Mass. Celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday at the International Shrine of Divine Mercy, dedicated by St. John Paul II during his last visit to Poland, and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Presentation of the Virgin Mary in Wadowice, where Karol Wojtyła was baptized.

Our pilgrimage promises to be a journey of great graces, camaraderie, and great memories! I look forward to being with you for this wonderful pilgrimage.

DAILY ITINERARY - Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

DAY 1 Monday, April 6: Depart USA

Depart your home gateway for Poland. Dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

DAY 2 Tuesday, April 7: Arrive in Warsaw

Upon arrival at Warsaw International Airport, meet our Polish tour manager/guide. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Warsaw, the capital of Poland. Enjoy a brief panoramic tour of the city. We'll visit St. Stanislaw Kostka Church, the national shrine of Bl. Jerzy Popieluszko, martyr for the faith. **Celebrate Mass.** After Mass, visit his grave located outside the church. Independent lunch. Check-in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

DAY 3 Wednesday, April 8: Highlights of Warsaw

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at St. James Convent**, where St. Faustina entered the Monastery. After receiving direction from the Lord in Łódź's Cathedral, St. Faustina arrived at this church on the outskirts of Warsaw, where the priest directed her to the home of a Catholic woman for lodging. During her stay with the Lipzye family, Faustina discerned her religious vocation with the Congregation of the Sisters of our Lady of Mercy on Żytnia Street. Enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour of Poland's capital. We will explore the Old Town, painstakingly rebuilt after World War II, with its charming little streets and cafes. Independent lunch. After lunch, visit the Żytnia Street Convent, where Sr. Faustina entered religious life. Continue to see the cathedral, Royal Castle, and the Warsaw Ghetto. Drive along the royal route to Łazienki Park, where we will see views of the palace. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel in Warsaw. (B,D)

DAY 4 Thursday, April 9: Niepokalanów | Częstochowa

Breakfast at our hotel. Depart Warsaw for Niepokalanów, where St. Maximilian Kolbe initiated the "City of the Immaculate," dedicated to the movement of Marian Consecration. By 1939, the city had expanded from eighteen friars to an incredible 650, making it the largest Catholic religious house in the world. Independent lunch. After lunch, continue to Częstochowa. Upon arrival we will **celebrate Mass at Jasna Góra Monastery in the Chapel of the Miraculous Icon of the Black Madonna.** After Mass, enjoy a guided visit of the monastery, with its Chapel of the Virgin, where the sacred icon is kept for veneration by the faithful. We will also visit the beautiful Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Nativity of Mary, with its magnificent Baroque altar depicting the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven. Tour the monastery's museum, which houses offerings from the prisoners of the Nazi and communist concentration camps. The treasury houses many votive offerings left by pilgrims, including those given to the monastery by Pope St. John Paul II. Check-in at our hotel in Częstochowa. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Częstochowa. (B,D)

DAY 5 Friday, April 10: Auschwitz | Kraków

Early breakfast at our hotel. Depart Częstochowa for Auschwitz. Upon arrival we will have a guided tour of the former concentration camp and museum. Auschwitz was a Nazi death camp, where over 4 million people, mostly of Jewish descent, were executed during World War II. We will see the starvation cell of prisoner 16770, priest and martyr St. Maximilian Kolbe, who willingly offered to die in place of another prisoner. Edith Stein (St. Theresa Benedicta) also died here. We will visit Auschwitz II-Birkenau, the largest of the more than 40 camps and sub-camps that made up the Auschwitz complex. Independent lunch. Continue to Kraków. Upon arrival, we will check-in at our hotel. **Mass location to be advised.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kraków. (B,D)

DAY 6 Saturday, April 11: Highlights of Kraków

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a guided tour of Kraków, starting at the majestic castle on Wawel Hill (optional entrance). Walk through its beautiful renaissance courtyard and visit the famous Wawel Cathedral, burial place of all but one of the Polish kings. Enjoy Kraków's historic

architecture as we make our way to see the Town Hall, Collegium Maius (the ancient building of Jagiellonian University), the Cloth Hall, and Saint Mary's Church, with the famous Wit Stwoszc' altar. We will also see Florian's Gate and the Barbican, the showpiece of the city's medieval defensive walls. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we will visit Saint Hyacinth's tomb at the Dominican Church, residence of the archbishop. Saint John Paul II was ordained here and lived here while Bishop of Kraków. **Celebrate Mass at the Dominican Church.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kraków. (B,D)

DAY 7 Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12: International Shrine of Divine Mercy

Breakfast at our hotel. Divine Mercy Sunday at the International Shrine of Divine Mercy (Łagiewniki) will be an experience to remember. Our day will begin with a brief time for prayer in the Chapel of St. Joseph where the image of Divine Mercy hangs above the earthly remains of St. Faustina. **Celebrate Mass** along with other English-speaking pilgrims from around the world (visiting priests may concelebrate). After Mass, explore the grounds of the shrine including the other chapels, convent cemetery, and Way of the Cross. Independent lunch.

The line will form to enter the main basilica for the Hour of Mercy (possibility of standing room only). Just before 3:00 p.m. the procession with the Blessed Sacrament will begin a Holy Hour of Mercy, including the Divine Mercy Chaplet prayed in different languages. After the Holy Hour, time will be given to go to the lower basilica for Confession. Return to the hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kraków. (B,D)

DAY 8 Monday, April 13: Kalwaria | Wadowice

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will leave Kraków to visit the Calvary Sanctuary in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska. When Karol Józef Wojtyła was eight years old, his mother died, and his father took him to Kalwaria, a Marian shrine close to Wadowice. Karol's lifelong devotion to the Virgin began on that trip. The shrine was established to provide pilgrims with a substitute for Jerusalem, which had been lost to the Muslim Turks and unavailable for veneration. After our visit, we will continue to Wadowice, hometown of St. John Paul II, born Karol Józef Wojtyła on May 18, 1920. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Presentation of the Virgin Mary**, where Karol Wojtyła was baptized. Independent lunch in Wadowice.

Visit the museum of St. John Paul II, recently renovated and reopened. The museum tells the story of the Greatest of the Poles, from his early years in the small multicultural town of Wadowice until his last days as a Bishop of Rome. We will also visit St. Joseph's Carmelite Monastery in Wadowice. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kraków. (B,D)

DAY 9 Tuesday, April 14: St. Francis Church | Saint John Paul II Center | Wieliczka

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at the Church of St. Francis of Assisi.** After Mass, we'll visit the Monastery where St. Maximilian Kolbe was a monk in 1919 and led his first service. After our visit we'll continue to the John Paul II Center. See the octagonal lower church and Chapel of the Relics (Kosciol Relikwii), decorated with images depicting events from the pontificate of Saint John Paul II and his visits to Marian shrines around the world. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we'll tour Wieliczka, one of the oldest salt mines in Europe. Wieliczka is a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created a world of underground salt lakes with a rich interior of decorated chapels, including the famous Blessed Kings Chapel, plus other galleries and workings made of salt.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Kraków. (B,D)

DAY 10 Wednesday, April 15: Return to the USA

Breakfast at our hotel. Possibility to celebrate Mass before our departure to the airport. This morning, we'll be transferred to Kraków Airport for our return flights to the USA. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Polish zloty valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The **\$500.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt.** If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. Once this program is launched, PWT will be sent information to apply online for an ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package does not include airline transportation. Peter's Way Tours can assist in booking airfare if requested. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is **\$2,995.00 per person sharing a twin room** (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group airport transfer, you are welcome to utilize it. **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$695.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily. All dinners include mineral water and wine or beer.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your

tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping. **(For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred).**
