Day 1 Monday, July 1: Depart USA

Depart Minneapolis-St. Paul for our overseas journey to Geneva, Switzerland. Complimentary meals will be served in flight. (D,B)

Day 2 Tuesday, July 2: Welcome to Geneva | Annecy

Arrive at Geneva International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable motor coach and will have a brief orientation tour of Geneva, where St. Francis de Sales served as a bishop. Continue to Thorens, where St. Francis de Sales was born. Visit the Château de Sales, home of the Sales family, and the chapel built on the location of the room where St. Francis was born. See the cross where St. Francis de Sales was inspired by God to create the Order of the Visitation. We will also visit the parish church where he was baptized and consecrated Bishop of Geneva. **Possible meeting with His Excellency Bishop Charles Morerod** (*subject to confirmation*). Independent lunch. Continue to the village of Annecy magnificently situated on what is known as the Blue Lake in the heart of the Savoy Alps. Here, St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal founded the Congregation of the Visitation at Annecy in 1610. **Celebrate Mass in St. Peter's Cathedral in Annecy.**

Holy Hour (location to be advised). Late afternoon we will check in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Annecy. (D)

Day 3 Wednesday, July 3: Footsteps of St. Francis de Sales

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Our day begins with Mass at the Basilica of the Visitation.** Following Mass, we will have a guided tour of the basilica and museum. Time will be given for prayer and shopping at the bookstore. Independent lunch. We will begin our walking tour in the footsteps of St. Francis de Sales with a visit to the Church of St. Francis de Sales (the first Visitation Monastery), the Gallery House (where the Visitation Order began), famous statue of St. Francis de Sales (center of town), Cathedral of St. Pierre (where Francis was ordained a priest and officiated as a bishop), Madame de Charmoisy's House (influential in the writing of the Introduction of the Devout Life), House of President Antoine Favre, and the places where the miracles attributed to St. Francis de Sales took place. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Annecy. (B,D)

Day 4 Thursday, July 4: Lyon | Ars | Villefranche sur Saone

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Annecy for Lyon to visit the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, which sits high atop the Fourvière Hill in Lyon. It was built between 1872 and 1876 in the typical Baroque style of the period and offers a magnificent view over the city. Like Sacré-Coeur in Paris, Lyon's Basilica was built to underline the might of the Roman Catholic Church after the Prussian defeat of France in 1870 that gave rise to the birth of the anticlerical Third Republic. Independent lunch. After lunch, we will visit Antiquaille - Cultural Center of Christianity in Lyon. Visit the Museum of Religious Art, a few steps from the house of Pauline Jaricot (House of Loreto). This new space allows for the preservation and restoration of the crypt mosaics, a remarkable example of the religious art of the nineteenth century in Lyon and the development of a symbolic site. This is where tradition places the "dungeon of St. Pothin", a place revered by Christians for three centuries. It proposes a historical and cultural course of Christianity. **Holy Hour at the Prison Chapel** (to be confirmed). After our visit we'll continue to visit the little town of Ars and the Shrine of St. John Vianney, known as the "Cure of Ars" and patron saint of parish priests. **Celebrate Mass in the beautiful church for priests throughout the world.** After Mass we'll continue to Villefranche sur Saone for hotel check-in. **Enjoy a festive Fourth of July dinner at the hotel restaurant.** Overnight at Hotel Mercure Villefranche en Beaujolais. (B,D)

Day 5 Friday, July 5: Paray-Le-Monial | Cluny | Blanot | Vezelay

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast visit Paray-le Monial, celebrated for the apparitions of Our Lord to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, where the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Our Lord originated in the Convent of the Visitation. Visit the great medieval church, built as the official basilica to commemorate this event. Time permitting, you may wish to walk and pray the Stations of the Cross. **Celebrate Mass at the Convent.** After Mass, we will venerate the Tomb of St. Claude de la Colombière, S.J., the confessor of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Independent lunch. Continue to Cluny to visit the ruins of the Benedictine Abbey founded by Duke William I, Duke of Aquitaine, in 910. The height of Clunian influence was from the second half of the 10th century through the early 12th. The abbey was sacked in 1562, and many of its valuable manuscripts were destroyed or removed. We'll continue to visit the Eucharistic miracle church in Blanot.

Holy Hour in the church. Continue to Vezelay for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at Hotel de la Poste et du Lion d'or in Vezelay. (B,D)

Day 6 Saturday, July 6: Vezelay | Nevers | Blois, Loire Valley

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **This morning, we will visit the Basilica of St. Mary Magdalene and celebrate Mass.** After Mass, we continue to Nevers to visit St. Gildard's Convent and pray before the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. At the conclusion of the eighteen apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes, St. Bernadette lived for 12 years as a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. St. Bernadette eventually died of asthma at the age of 35. In the same chapel is the heart of Father Thomas Price, one of the founders of Maryknoll.

Holy Hour (location to be advised). Independent lunch. Continue to Blois in the Loire Valley. Dinner and overnight at Novotel Blois Centre in the Loire Valley. (B,D)

Day 7 Sunday, July 7: Tours | Saint Laurent sur Sevres | Rennes

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit the Basilica of St. Martin in Tours, built over the tomb of this popular French saint. Martin, along with his contemporary Hilary of Poitiers, was instrumental in the establishment of Christianity in Western Europe, as well as halting the spread of Arianism.

Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. After our visit we'll continue to Saint-Lauren sur Sevres. Independent lunch en route. Visit Saint-Lauren sur Sevres, the town well known for being the burial place of St. Louis de Montfort and Blessed Marie Louise Trichet. On September 19, 1996, St. John Paul II visited the town to meditate and pray near the tombs of St. Louis de Montfort and Blessed Marie Louise. Saint John Paul II's strong Marian devotion was highly influenced by St. Louis de Montfort. According to his Apostolic Letter Rosarium Virginis Mariae, the pontif's personal motto "Totus Tuus" was inspired by St. Louis' doctrine on total consecration to the Virgin Mary.

Holy Hour (to be confirmed). Continue to Rennes for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at the Mercure Rennes Centre Gare. (B,D)

Day 8 Monday, July 8: Saint-Pern | Mont-St.Michel | Lisieux

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, drive to Saint Pern, the burial place of St. Jeanne Jugan, and location of the motherhouse for the Little Sisters of the Poor. **Celebrate Mass in the Chapel of La Tour St. Joseph.** Independent lunch en route. Continue to the country's northwestern coast, at the mouth of the Couesnon River near Avranches. We will approach this tiny island by a causeway built in 1877, and enter the medieval village of 250 inhabitants by three massive stone gates. Upon arrival we will visit the beautiful monastery of Mont-St-Michel. Surrounded by the sea and soaring proudly above glistening sands, the silhouette of Mont-St-Michel is one of the most enchanting sights in all of France. The great Benedictine Abbey Fortress that crowns this mass of granite was begun in 1017. A monastery built on three levels was added to the church's north side in the early 13th century. **Holy Hour** (to be confirmed). Late afternoon, continue to Lisieux, the home of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

Day 9 Tuesday, July 9: Lisieux | D-Day Landings

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Thérèse. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica.** After Mass, we'll continue to visit "Les Buissonnets," the humble dwelling of this modern-day saint until she entered the Carmel Convent at the age of 15. **Holy Hour at the Carmel Convent.** Independent lunch. Continue to the Normandy Beaches and sites of the D-Day Landings. On June 6, 1944, tens of thousands of American, English, Canadian, Scottish and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy coast to free France from the Nazi stronghold. Thousands of young soldiers died that first day in the name of liberty. The coast of Normandy still has the indelible scars of that event. We'll then Omaha beach, the most famous of the Normandy landing beaches. Finally, we'll visit the American cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer where these young soldiers are buried. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lisieux. (B,D)

Day 10 Wednesday, July 10: Argenteuil | Montmartre

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we'll leave Lisieux to Paris. On our way we'll stop just north of the city to visit the Basilica of St. Denis in Argenteuil which houses the seamless garment believed to have been worn by Christ during His Passion. The Tunic is kept in a reliquary in the basilica and is exhibited only twice a century. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Denis.** After our visit we'll continue to Montmartre for an independent lunch. After lunch, visit the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Montmartre with its amazing view of Paris. In 1870, war broke out between France and Germany, and France was invaded. The idea took hold that the ordeals incurred by France were due to its spiritual faults as well as its political ones. This gave birth to the construction of a basilica dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This project was seen as atonement and also as the force of hope and spiritual renewal. Parisian and French Christians pledge to maintain a permanent 24/7 prayer in exchange for the protection of Paris. In 1872, the archbishop of Paris approved the project and chose the hill of Montmartre for the site. For over a century, Parisians and pilgrims from all over the world maintain permanent prayer. We will pause for a period of time to participate in **Perpetual Adoration at the Basilica.** We will also visit the Church of St. Pierre de Montmartre and the Chapel where St. Ignatius Loyola founded the Jesuits at the base of Montmartre. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 11 Thursday, July 11: Medieval Paris | Dinner Cruise

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we'll begin our day with a visit to Rue de Bac. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal.** Continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent DePaul. Although there are many churches in Paris related to Vincent's activities, it is in this Chapel where we will see and pray near a richly adorned silver shrine containing the body of the saint renowned for compassion, humility, and generosity to the poor. Continue to the Ile de la Cité and the Cathedral Notre-Dame de Paris, a jewel of gothic art and symbol of Paris and of Christian France. Next, we will visit Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of Flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité in Paris. Discover its unique stained glass windows, symbols of the heavenly Jerusalem. Independent lunch. This afternoon, our guide will show us the remarkable sights of this magnificent and romantic city on the River Seine. End our day with a visit to the Blessed Sacrament Fathers' Corpus Christi Chapel where Father Eymard held the first public Exposition of the Eucharist. Visit the Blessed Sacrament Chapel where the saintly remains of St. Peter Julian Eymard are preserved and venerated. **Holy Hour** (to be confirmed).

This evening enjoy a dinner cruise aboard the famous Parisian "bateaux-mouches." We'll have a view of all the most beautiful sites of Paris from the Seine! Overnight at our hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 12 Friday, July 12: Return to the USA

After a very early breakfast, we will be transferred to Paris CDG International Airport for our return flight to the USA.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If a final payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$350.00 tour deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. We do not refund costs associated with tour services that are not utilized.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation based on availability. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: It is the traveler's responsibility to have a valid passport for international travel. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all required documents are complete and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents, including passports.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Minneapolis-St. Paul. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). If you purchase independent connecting flights, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not independently purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed by Peter's Way Tours for travel.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. However, there is no guarantee that requests will be honored. Peter's Way cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available for purchase (contact our office to inquire). Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package cost is \$3,495.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying Peter's Way Tours in writing, up to 100 days prior to date of departure. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure (additional fees will apply). An increase in airfare may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage, per person, is included at most hotels.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds and private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. **Single rooms are limited and may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$695.00 will apply.** We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily, including a dinner cruise on the Seine.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. Peter's Way Tours must be advised if a person has a disability requiring assistance. Any passenger who requires special assistance must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible if we are unable to do so.
